- 1) The purpose for this study is to assess the effects of plant extracts on horses or ponies with Equine Cushing's Disease or Metabolic Syndrome.
- 2) Participation in the study involves provision of blood samples, taken by your own veterinary surgeon, before and after treatment and adherence to the treatment protocol set out in the enclosed literature. Photographs of the animal before, during and after treatment would be very useful but are not mandatory.
- 3) Participation is voluntary and any decision not to participate will in no way compromise the care and treatment of the animal involved.
- 4) The risks of participation in this trial are minimal. Administration of the trial substances, in excess of the recommended administration rates, has produced temporary mild physical hyperactivity. No other side effects have been noted to date in the animals which have been given the trial substances. The blood sampling process is simple and should pose no untoward risks. Animals should not be sedated prior to sampling but handled in a quiet manner.
- 5) You are responsible for the payment of your veterinary surgeons fees for visiting and obtaining blood samples from your animal at the beginning and end of the trial.

6) We require a £35.00 contribution from you towards the comprehensive blood analysis that we are providing, as this is an expensive test. This needs to be submitted as a separate cheque. We will refund this sum to you if your horse is eligible for the trial.

7) To join the trial itself, a deposit of £100.00 is required. This will be cashed when the trial product is sent out to you and then refunded when the second set of blood samples has been received and all paper work submitted. Please send a cheque for £100.00 made payable to Equi Life Ltd along with your signed consent form.

8) Eligibility to participate in the trial will depend on your horse or pony's laboratory analyses alongside our receipt of your signed consent form and two cheques (one for £35.00 and one for £100.00). Should your horse/pony's results be such that they are not eligible for inclusion in the trial, your deposit cheque of £100.00 will be returned to you immediately. You will still be responsible for your veterinary surgeon's fees.
